KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 81-166

PROVIDING FOR THE NOMINATION OF CERTAIN LANDS FOR CONVEYANCE FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA TO THE BOROUGH PURSUANT TO THE MUNICIPAL LAND SELECTION ACT.

WHEREAS, the Borough is eligible to select certain additional vacant and unappropriated State lands for conveyance from the State of Alaska to the Borough pursuant to the Municipal Land Section Act, AS 29.18.201 through AS 29.18.213 as amended to date; and

WHEREAS, certain available lands have been identified as being desirable for nomination as Borough selections; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Planning Commission recommended at its September 21, 1981, meeting that the lands described in this resolution be selected by the Borough for conveyance from the State of Alaska as part of its entitlement under the Municipal Land Selection law;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That these described lands are nominated by the Borough Assembly for conveyance to the Borough from the State of Alaska pursuant to the Borough's entitlement under the Municipal Selection Act:

T4N, R11W, S.M., Alaska

Sec. 25 W 1/2 W 1/2, comprising approximately 160 acres and located five (5) miles south of Soldotna and one and one-half (1.5) miles east of the Sterling Highway.

Sec. 36 - All, comprising approximately 640 acres and located six (6) miles south of Soldotna and one and one-half (1.5) miles east of the Sterling Highway.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate this resolution which takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
