RESOLUTION 81-168

ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF TRANS-ALASKA ENGINEERING TO PERFORM PRELIMINARY PHOTO MAPPING AND SURVEY WORK FOR RESURRECTION RIVER ROAD.

WHEREAS, the Assembly desire to provide for the upgrading of Resurrection River Road and for its reconstruction in certain areas; and

WHEREAS, the firm of Trans-Alaska Engineering has offered to perform all preliminary survey, aerial photography and topographical mapping of the existing Resurrection River Road for a price not to exceed \$40,330; and

WHEREAS, performance of these tasks is necessary before a final road alignment may be selected and before design work may begin; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available and the Department of Public Works has reviewed the proposal and has recommended that the Assembly award a contract for this work to Trans-Alaska Engineering;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the proposal of Trans-Alaska Engineering to perform all preliminary survey, aerial photography and topographical mapping of Resurrection River Road for a cost not to exceed \$40,330 is accepted and a contract is awarded.

Section 2. That the sum of \$45,000 is transferred from the Road Design Contingency Account No. 65-21001-9007 to the Resurrection River Road Account No. 65-21043-9007.

Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate this resolution, which takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
