RESOLUTION 81-174

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT FOR THE DESIGN OF A PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE OVER THE RESURRECTION RIVER TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO EXIT GLACIER VIA THE RESURRECTION RIVER ROAD.

WHEREAS, the Assembly by Resolution 81-105 approved funds for the design of a bridge across Resurrection River; and

WHEREAS, an existing stockpiled bridge has been determined to be too short and too weak for this particular span; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration and the U.S. Park Service are contemplating improvements in the area which would be assisted and perhaps expedited by the Resurrection River Pedestrian Bridge; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has been in contact with the Department of Transportation and U.S. Park Service in a cooperative planning action; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has evaluated the availability of qualified engineers who are bridge designers; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department recommends the award of a contract for the design of the pedestrian bridge;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Peratrovich & Nottingham for the design of the Resurrection River Pedestrian Bridge near Exit Glacier for a contract cost of not more than \$12,250. The cost of this contract shall be charged to LSR&T Account #07-21035-9007.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate this resolution which takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
