AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SURPLUS BOROUGH PERSONAL PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the Borough School District has declared certain items of personal property surplus to their needs; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has personal property surplus to its needs; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly on August 4, 1970, adopted a memorandum outlining procedures for disposal of surplus property which required an appraisal of all property prior to disposal; and

WHEREAS, an appraisal requires the expenditure of time and monies far beyond its worth; and

WHEREAS, the Borough does not have professional auctioneering talent;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- Section 1. That all items shown on the list entitled "Kenai Peninsula Borough Surplus Property Auction, 1981", which is made a part of this resolution, are declared surplus to the needs of the Borough.
- Section 2. Provisions for the August 4, 1970, memorandum requiring appraisal of property will be waived and an auction will be held at 10 a.m., October 31, 1981.
- Section 3. The auction will be legally advertised in a newspaper of the Borough at least 10 days prior to the auction.
- Section 4. Personal property to be auctioned will be on public display on Friday, October 30, 1981, in the quonset behind the Borough Administration Building from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Section 5. A professional auctioneer will conduct a public outcry auction based on the highest bid, in accord with regular auctioneering rules and practices.
