RESOLUTION 81-186

AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT FOR THE
INSTALLATION OF MONITORING WELLS AT THE SOLDOTNA LANDFILL.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska Department of Environmental
Conservation, the Borough's Department of Public Works and
residents living near the Soldotna Landfill have identified the
need for establishing a ground water monitoring program around
the landfill; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works recommends the
acceptance of the proposal of Mike Tauriainen, P.E., to provide
the ground water monitoring program at the Soldotna Landfill;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the proposal of Mike Tauriainen, P.E., to
to provide all engineering, laboratory and supervisual services
necessary to establish the water monitoring program is
accepted.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into a
contract with Mike Tauriainen, P.E., to perform the services
for a fee of \$25,360 plus 10% contingency for a total contract
cost not to exceed \$27,500.

Section 3. That the sum of \$27,500 is transferred from
Sterling Alternate Contingency Account No. 63-29181-9007 to
Soldotna Landfill Account No. 63-28881-9215 and this contract
shall be charged to Account No. 63-28881-9215.

Section 4. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate
this resolution which takes effect immediately upon its
adoption.
