RESOLUTION 81-188

ADJUSTING THE RATE OF THE MILL LEVY UPON CERTAIN REMOTE LANDS  
LYING WITHIN THE RIDGEWAY FIRE SERVICE AREA.

WHEREAS, certain sparsely populated lands within the  
Ridgeway Fire Service Area are completely inaccessible to  
firefighting vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Borough may adjust the rate of the mill levy  
upon lands within a service area where performance of the  
service area's power is impossible due to conditions; and

WHEREAS, the homestead of Mr Clyde Mullican is located  
within the Ridgeway Fire Service Area near Soldotna Lake, and  
is approximately six miles from the nearest road usable by  
firefighting vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Mullican has requested that he be excused  
from the payment of fire service area taxes in view of the  
impossibility of providing fire protection to him and the Fire  
Service Area Board has requested that the Assembly adjust the  
service area's mill levy in order to eliminate the fire service  
area mill rate levy upon these lands;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI  
PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the 1981 real property tax levy upon the  
lands included in Assessor's Tax Parcel Number 058-010-0100-8  
shall be adjusted to include only the Borough's general  
government mill rate and Central Peninsula General Hospital  
Service Area mill rate and that a mill rate for the Ridgeway  
Fire Service Area shall not be levied until the land is  
accessible to firefighting vehicles.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately  
upon its adoption.
