RESOLUTION 81-189

REQUESTING THE SECOND SESSION OF THE TWELFTH LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA TO INCREASE STATE AID TO NATIVE VILLAGE GOVERNMENTS TO PERMIT THE INCLUSION OF SOCIAL SERVICE PROGRAMS IN THE VILLAGES AS A SUPPLEMENT TO THE MUNICIPAL ASSISTANCE TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS IN ALASKA.

WHEREAS, the State Legislature has appropriated money for municipal assistance to local governments in Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the state law authorizes state grants to be passed on to non-profit corporations to provide social services and other municipal programs in a municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Regional Affairs has ruled that a municipality dispensing this money to the non-profit corporations must possess the underlying municipal power to engage in such activity; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Penininsula Borough, as a second class borough, does not possess the municipal power to perform social services; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is precluded from dispensing funds to non-profit corporations or native villages to perform social services; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska provides state aid to native village governments;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Second Session of the Twelfth Legislature of the State of Alaska is requested to provide additional funds and state aid and the grant of authority to native village governments in order that these local governing bodies or village councils may provide social services to their inhabitants.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption and the Clerk shall serve copies of this resolution upon the Honorable Jay S. Hammond, Governor of the State of Alaska, the Honorable Jalmar Kerttula, President of the State Senate, the Honorable Joe L. Hayes, Speaker of the
