RESOLUTION 81-19

EXPRESSING THE BOROUGH'S NON-OBJECTION TO A PROPOSED
RURAL DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE GRANT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION
OF A FIRE STATION IN THE VILLAGE OF ENGLISH BAY.

WHEREAS, the Village of English Bay will be receiving
a new fire truck and fire fighting equipment in the near
future and it desires to construct a fire station to house
this equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Village has applied for a Rural Development
Assistance Grant to construct a fire station and will be
wholly responsible for the upkeep and maintenance of this
building; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has requested that the
Assembly state that it has no objection to the proposed
project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE
KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly expresses its support
for the application of the Village of English Bay for a
Rural Development Assistance Grant for the construction
of a fire station in the Village, to be wholly maintained
by the Village.

Section 2. That the Clerk shall serve a copy of this
resolution upon the Honorable Vince Kvasnikoff, Chief of
the Village of English Bay and upon North Pacific Rim, Inc.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immed-
iately upon its adoption.
