KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 81-190

TO DECLARE THE INTENTION OF THE ASSEMBLY TO ALLOW PRIVATE ENTERPRISE UNTIL JULY 1, 1982 TO SOLVE THE BOROUGH'S SEPTIC WASTE DISPOSAL PROBLEMS.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 81-112 proposed the acquisition of municipal powers necessary to provide sewers and septage waste treatment facilities in the Borough area outside cities; and

WHEREAS, at the Assembly meeting of November 3, 1981, that ordinance failed introduction because its consideration could adversely affect the efforts of private enterprise to provide for septic waste disposal in the Borough; and

WHEREAS, septic waste disposal is a long standing problem which continues to become more aggravated and in need of remedial action; and

WHEREAS, the basic alternatives are private enterprise or government enterprise; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly and the administration prefer private enterprise;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly declares its intention to allow private enterprise the opportunity to solve the Borough's septic waste disposal problem by proposing and establishing a viable and efficient septage waste disposal program in the Borough area outside cities on or before July 1, 1982. The private enterprise system must meet the approval of the Borough, and complying with all other licensing requirements and government regulations and permits.

Section 2. If private enterprise does not institute a septic waste disposal system, it is the expressed intention of the Assembly to begin the process to obtain the necessary municipal powers which will authorize the Borough to establish a septic waste disposal system for the Borough area outside cities, subject to a vote of the people at a regular or special election on the question.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
