KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 81-194

RECOMMENDING THAT SECTION LOT 4, SECTION 24, T4N, R12W, S.M., WEST OF KALIFONSKY BEACH ROAD CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 27 ACRES BE CONSIDERED BY THE STATE HISTORIC SITES ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR NOMINATION TO THE NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the site of the Kalifornsky Village is located on Section Lot 4, Section 24, T4N, R12W, S.M.; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission at its November 16, 1981, meeting has recommended that the village site be preserved;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the lands within Section Lot 4, Section 24, T4N, R12W, S.M., be recommended for nomination by the State Historic Sites Advisory Committee for nomination to the National Register of Historic Places.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate this resolution which takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
