RESOLUTION 81-204

AMENDING RESOLUTION 81-146 TO REFLECT THE TRANSFER OF MUNICIPAL ASSISTANCE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE KINGSLEY-OILWELL ROAD PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Assembly, by Resolution 81-146 allocated municipal assistance grant funds to various capital improvement projects within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 81-146 should be amended to reflect the transfer of funds to the Kingsley-Oilwell Road project accomplished by Resolution 81-203; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has previously awarded by resolution contracts for the design of various road projects within the Borough and the amounts allocated to road design should be clarified by reflecting the individual contracts awarded;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Resolution 81-146 is amended to read:

The \$7,331,640 received from the State Assistance for Municipalities Program for the Year 1981-82 will be expended as follows to upgrade existing facilities:

Solid Waste	\$ 845,000
Road Design	\$ 649,500
Road Construction	\$4,970,000
Right-of-Way and Land Acquisition	\$ 247,140
Kingsley-Oilwell Road	\$ 620,000

Section 2. That Resolution 81-146 is amended by adding a new Section 2 which reads:

The road design account set out in Section 1 of Resolution 81-146 shall be expended in accordance with the following contracts in force as of December 15, 1981:
