RESOLUTION 81-21

URGING THE REPEAL OF THE ALASKA COASTAL ZONE MANAGEMENT ACT.

WHEREAS, the Alaska Legislature has enacted AS 46.40 and AS 44.19.155, et. seq., which provide for an Alaska Coastal Policy Council; and

WHEREAS, the Coastal Zone Management Act has proven to be an unworkable and unacceptable intrusion of State control over the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Coastal Zone Management Act imposes land use restrictions upon local municipalities, which should have priority in dealing with land use questions arising within their boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the State of Alaska Department of Natural Resources and commissioners of other State agencies, transmitted a memorandum to the Governor of the State indicating that the Coastal Zone Management Act was, in their opinion, a "procedural monster that seems to gain us nothing but governmental inefficiency", and suggested that the administration announce its intention to repeal the act; and

WHEREAS, repeal of the coastal management act would result in eliminating a significant number of unneeded State employment positions, in loosening the regulatory restrictions now imposed by the State upon local land use planning, and in returning control of land use planning to the affected municipalities and their citizens;

Section 1. That the Assembly urges the Twelfth Legislature, First Session, to repeal the Alaska Coastal Management Act, AS 46.40 and the Alaska Coastal Policy Council Enabling Act, AS 44.19.155, et seq., and to return complete control over local land use questions to affected municipalities.

Section 2. That the Assembly decries the attempt by the Governor of the State of Alaska to stifle internal policy discussion regarding developmental and environmental issues affecting all citizens.

Section 3. That the Clerk shall serve a copy of this resolution upon The Honorable Jay S. Hammond, Governor of the State of Alaska, upon The Honorable Jay Kerttula, President of the State Senate, upon The Honorable Speaker of the State House, upon The Honorable Donald E. Gilman, State Senator, and upon The Honorables Bette Cato, Hugh Malone, and Pat O'Connell, State Representatives.

Section 4. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
