KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 81-28

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATURE TO PROVIDE FUNDS TO CORRECT DEFICIENCIES IDENTIFIED AT THE NINILCHIK SCHOOL BY THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities has identified safety deficiencies and educational deficiencies in the facilities of the combined Elementary and High School at Ninilchik; and

WHEREAS, the correction of the deficiencies identified by the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities would cost in excess of \$500,000.00 and these funds were to have been provided to the Borough through a bond issue on the November 1980 ballot, but that bond issue failed; and

WHEREAS, the voters of the Borough approved the use of surplus 1978 bond proceeds for the provision of necessary additions and alterations to the Nikolaevsk and Ninilchik schools, but the available funds fell short of the amounts required to fund these projects by approximately \$580,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the design development documents for the Ninilchik school project provide for the correction of many of the deficiencies identified by the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities survey, and these deficiencies result in part from the original design and construction of the Ninilchik school prior to organization of the Borough .

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH.

Section 1: That the Assembly requests the Twelfth Legislature, First Session, to appropriate the sum of \$580,000.00 to correct the safety and other deficiencies identified by the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities at the combined Elementary and High School at Ninilchik.

Section 2: That the clerk shall serve a copy of this Resolution upon the Honorable Jay S. Hammond, Governor of the State of Alaska, upon the Honorable J. Kerttula, President of the State Senate, upon the Honorable Speaker of the State House, upon the Honorable Donald E. Gilman, State Senator and upon the Honorables Bette Cato, Hugh Malone and Pat O'Connell, State Representatives.

Section 3: That this Resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
