KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 81-31

ALLOCATING TO SERVICE AREAS IN THE BOROUGH THE AMOUNT OF MONEY THAT EACH SERVICE AREA RECEIVED IN FISCAL YEAR 1979-80, IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE REVENUE SHARING REQUIREMENTS.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the current State Revenue Sharing Program, certain service areas are not allocated specific funds based on population; and

WHEREAS, the Borough now receives all money from state-shared revenues with no specific provision for distribution to service areas, except hospital service areas and road service areas, and

WHEREAS, the latest expression of the law in Section 12, Chapter 155 SLA 1980 states in part "Payment of an entitlement to a borough under 29.88 may be made to a borough only if the borough assembly agrees to allocate to each borough service area in the borough at least the amount of money that the service area received during the last fiscal year under the former provisions of AS 43.18.010 - 43.18.045 in accordance with those provisions."

WHEREAS, the effect of this latest state law is to designate all borough service areas funded in fiscal year 1979-80 as recipients of state income sharing funds:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That in fiscal year 1981-82 the borough service areas affected by new state revenue sharing requirements will receive the same amount of funds from the borough allocation of \$210,979 as they received in fiscal year 1979-80:

Nikiski Fire Service Area	\$28,299.00
North Peninsula Recreation Service Area	\$20,543.00
Bear Creek Fire Service Area	\$ 5,321.00

The balance of \$156,816.00 from State Revenue Sharing will be deposited in the Borough's General Fund.

Section 3. The Mayor is authorized to effectuate this resolution, which takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
