KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 81-40

AUTHORIZING THE LEASE/PURCHASE OF AN UPGRADED TELEPHONE SYSTEM IN THE BOROUGH ADMINISTRATION BUILDING.

WHEREAS, the Borough is presently renting its telephone system at a monthly rent of \$1,950, a system which needs updating to meet all the Borough requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Glacier State Telephone Company has available the Siemens SD-192MX telephone system which can provide expansion features to meet the Borough's requirements;

WHEREAS, the Borough can lease this telephone system at a lower monthly cost than the present system cost, with an option to purchase; and

WHEREAS, this proposed system will more adequately meet the Borough requirements and will improve service to the public;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into a lease-purchase contract with Glacier State Telephone Company for a Siemens SD-192/232 EPABX telephone system. The terms shall be \$1,418.56 per month for 120 months, or a purchase price of \$104,000.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
