TRANSFERRING THE SUM OF \$8,000 TO ASSIST IN THE PREPARATION AND PUBLICATION OF THE KENAI-NIKISKI AND SEWARD-FOURTH OF JULY CREEK SITING PROPOSALS FOR THE DOW/SHELL PETROCHEMICAL PROJECT.

WHEREAS, a consortium of petrochemical companies including Dow Chemical Company and Shell Oil Company have been commissioned by the State of Alaska to prepare a feasibility study regarding the siting and development of a petrochemical plant utilizing gas liquids from the North Slope oil and gas fields; and

WHEREAS, the consortium is considering the siting of this plant in various locations around the state, including two sites within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the construction of this project within the Borough area would be in the interests of the Borough and its citizens and would greatly expand the Borough's tax base; and

WHEREAS, the preparation and presentation of siting proposals showing the advantages of the proposed Wildwood and Fourth of July Creek sites would greatly assist the Borough in obtaining this project; and
