AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR THE NIKOLAEVSK SCHOOL ADDITIONS AND RENOVATIONS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the School Board and the Assembly have approved necessary additions and renovations at the Nikolaevsk School; and

WHEREAS, architectural design plans have been approved by the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has solicited and received bids for the project; and

WHEREAS, the successful bidder has been nominated and approved by the Public Works Department and the Finance Department and the award of a bid is recommended; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has appropriated the necessary funds by Ordinance 81-31;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Nikolaevsk School Additions and Renovations project contract is awarded to AHTNA/KNAPP as follows:

Base Bid - Four classroom, library and multi-purpose	\$1,074,195

Add Alternates:

1. Two additional classrooms	\$ 109,950
2. Gravel fill	\$ 5,700
3. Re-roof existing	\$ 50,900
TOTAL BID AWARD	\$1,240,745

The cost of this project shall be charged to Account No. 62-13681-9007.

Section 2. It is the specific intention and directive of the Assembly in adopting this resolution, that it be incor-

porated by reference in the contract and made a part of the contract as if fully set forth and it is a further specific condition of this contract award that the contractor by accepting the contract award specifically commits itself to providing any one of these roofing systems:

Kaiser "Zip-Rib"
Architectural Panels, Inc., "Rib-Lok"
Architectural Products, Inc., "Perma-Seam"
Batten System

A failure by the contractor to provide any of these systems which are deemed equal under the specifications for this contract shall be deemed without more to be a material breach of contract.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
