A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A GRANT OR SPECIAL APPROPRIATION TO THE BOROUGH FOR THE USE AND BENEFIT OF THE RIDGEWAY SERVICE AREA FOR THE PURCHASE OF FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPMENT AND RELATED FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the Ridgeway Fire Service Area Board of Directors has adopted a resolution requesting the Assembly to support a grant or special appropriation from the State of Alaska for the purchase of fire fighting equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly supports the fire service area board in seeking a grant or special appropriation to assist in its efforts to acquire fire fighting capabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly supports the participation of the fire service area in current legislative proposals before the Twelfth Legislature of the State of Alaska to fund appropriations of grants or direct appropriations to assist local governments and fire departments;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly declares its support for the resolution adopted by the Board of Directors of the Redigeway Fire Service Area on May 6, 1981, requesting a special appropriation or grant in the amount of \$349,000 for the purchase of fire fighting equipment and related facilities from special appropriations or grant funds which may be made available by legislative enactment in the First Session, Twelfth Legislature of the State of Alaska.

Section 2. This resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption and shall be served upon the Honorable Jay S. Hammond, Governor of the State of Alaska, upon the Honorable Jalmar Kerttula, President of the State Senate, upon the Honorable James Duncan, Speaker of the House, upon the Honorable Donald E. Gilman, State Senator, and upon the Honorables Bette Cato, Hugh Malone, and Pat O'Connell, State Representatives. The Assembly earnestly solicits the Peninsula legislative delegation to support and actively promote necessary grants and appropriations for the purposes stated in this resolution.
