RESOLUTION 81-94

AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION AND PURCHASE OF A NEW AND IMPROVED
TELEPHONE SYSTEM FOR THE CENTRAL PENINSULA HOSPITAL SERVICE
AREA.

WHEREAS, the Borough, on behalf of Central Peninsula
General Hospital Service Area, solicited proposals for the
provision and installation of an advanced telephone system
for the Central Peninsula General Hospital; and

WHEREAS, the Service Area Board, at its regular meeting
of May 14, 1981, examined the proposals and recommended
acceptance of the proposal of Glacier State Telephone
Company to provide a complete telephone system to be incor-
porated into the Phase I Central Peninsula General Hospital
Additions and Renovations Project for the sum of \$40,840;
and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE
KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the proposal of Glacier State Telephone
Company to provide, install and maintain a complete telephone
system in accordance with the terms and conditions of its
proposal for the amount of '\$40,840 is accepted and a contract
is awarded. All expenditures for this project shall be
charged to the Central Peninsula General Hospital Telephone
Account No. 53-45-210-9170.

Section 2. That the sum of \$40,840 is transferred from
the Hospital Contingency Account No. 53-45-210-9007 to the
Hospital Telephone Account No. 53-45-210-9170.

Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate
this resolution, which takes effect immediately upon its
adoption.
