NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the proposal of Glacier State Telephone Company to provide, install and maintain a complete telephone system in accordance with the terms and conditions of its proposal for the amount of '\$40,840 is accepted and a contract is awarded. All expenditures for this project shall be charged to the Central Peninsula General Hospital Telephone Account No. 53-45-210-9170.

Section 2. That the sum of \$40,840 is transferred from the Hospital Contingency Account No. 53-45-210-9007 to the Hospital Telephone Account No. 53-45-210-9170.

Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate this resolution, which takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
