KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 81-96

RATIFYING A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH AND THE BOROUGH EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION RELATING TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 1981-1982.

WHEREAS, Section 3.04.280 of the Borough Code provides for the adoption of collective bargaining agreements by resolution; and .

WHEREAS, the Borough Assembly by Resolution 79-59, previously ratified the present collective bargaining agreement between the Borough and the Borough Employees Association, which expires on June 30, 1981; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly, by Resolution 80-90, approved certain revisions to the collective bargaining agreement; and

WHEREAS, through good-faith negotiations an agreement has been reached between the Borough and the Kenai Borough Employees Association regarding wages, salaries, benefits and other terms and conditions of employment for the fiscal year 1981-1982; and

WHEREAS, the collective bargaining agreement has been ratified by the Employees Association and the Administration recommends that the Assembly ratify the agreement incorporated as Attachment A;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the collective bargaining agreement to become effective July 1, 1981, through June 30, 1982, is approved. The agreement is attached as Attachment A to this resolution and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. This resolution takes effect on July 1, 1981, if the collective bargaining agreement has been duly ratified by the Kenai Borough Employees Association, or on such later date this resolution is adopted by the Assembly.
