KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 81-99

PROVIDING FOR THE BROADCASTING OF REGULAR AND SPECIAL ASSEMBLY MEETINGS AND TRANSFERRING FUNDS.

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the citizens of the Borough be as fully informed as possible regarding matters brought before the Assembly; and

WHEREAS, the most effective method of informing the citizens of the Borough is through the live broadcastings of all regular Borough Assembly meetings; and

WHEREAS, it is commercially infeasible for radio stations to broadcast the full proceedings of each regular Assembly meeting without contractual assistance from the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly desires that its meetings be broadcast during Fiscal Year 1981-1982;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the sum of \$27,360 is transferred from the Assembly Contingency Account No. 01-1110-7300 to the Assembly Contract Services Account No. 01-1110-3400 and that this sum shall be utilized to contract with radio stations KRXA (Seward), KQOK (Central Peninsula), and KGTL (South Peninsula), at the rate of \$250 per month for each radio station with \$105 per month for KQOK for phone hookup, for the broadcasting of all regular Borough Assembly meetings from July 1, 1981, through June 30, 1982.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate this resolution, which takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
