RESOLUTION 82-2 (Amended)

ESTABLISHING A POLICY AND LIMITATION ON PAYMENT FOR ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENTS ON DESIGNATED ROAD CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the Borough has assumed road construction powers; and

WHEREAS, in order to construct roads across private property it is usually necessary to obtain easements from property owners; and

WHEREAS, the easement requirements and additional right-of-way vary with conditions and road design;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly authorizes this right-of-way policy for designated road construction projects:

- A. Fifty dollars (\$50.00) shall be paid to the owner for a standard right-of-way easement.
- B. The Mayor shall be authorized to make payment to the property owner in cases where the granting of the easement shall require additional private property or rights, provided, however, that payment shall be limited to not more than \$10,000 based on real estate appraisal by the Assessor or independent appraisal.
- C. In cases where the owner demands payment of more than \$10,000, the payment must first be authorized by the Assembly.

Section 2. That the expenditure of funds for right-of-way acquisition in the individual project accounts shall be made by transfer from Account No. 65-21001-9212 as established by Resolution 81-204 in the amount of \$247,140.

Section 3. That the expenditure of funds for right-of-way acquisition shall be limited to the following roads: North Anchor River, Halbouty, Mackey Lake/Sport Lake, Holt,

Section 4. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate this resolution which takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
