RESOLUTION 82-3

AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SURPLUS BOROUGH PERSONAL PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the Bear Creek Fire Department has declared certain items of personal property surplus to its needs; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly finds this personal property surplus to its needs; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly on August 4, 1970, adopted a memorandum outlining procedures for disposal of surplus property which requires an appraisal of all property prior to disposal; and

WHEREAS, an appraisal requires the expenditure of time and money not justified for this disposal; and

WHEREAS, professional auctioneering services are available at reasonable expense;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That these items on the Bear Creek Fire Service Area Surplus Property 1982 list are declared surplus to the needs of the Borough:

Section 2. The provision of the August 4, 1970, Assembly Memorandum requiring appraisal of the property are waived and an auction will be held at 10:00 a.m., January 25, 1982.

Section 3. The auction will be legally advertised in a newspaper of the Borough at least 10 days prior to the auction.

Section 4. Personal property to be auctioned will be on public display at the Bear Creek Fire Department, Bear Creek, Alaska, from the date of public notification to the sale date.

Section 5. A professional auctioneer will conduct a public outcry auction based on the highest bid, in accordance with regular auctioneering rules and practices.

Section 6. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
