RESOLUTION 82-6
(SUBSTITUTE)

CHANGING THE NAME OF THE EAST HOMER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO THE
PAUL BANKS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, residents of the Homer area have petitioned the
School Board to rename the East Homer Elementary School to the
Paul Banks Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Paul Banks has been an employee of the School
District at the East Homer Elementary School for many years and
rendered exemplary service to the school and to the community
above and beyond the call of duty; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Board of Education,
at its regular meeting of December 7, 1981, recommended that
the Borough Assembly rename the East Homer Elementary School as
the Paul Banks Elementary School;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the East Homer Elementary School is
renamed the Paul Banks Elementary School in recognition of the
service rendered by Mr. Paul Banks above and beyond the call of
duty to the school and to the community during his many years
of service.

Section 2. That this resolution be inscribed on a bronze
plaque and placed in an appropriate setting on the school
property for the edification and enrichment of the lives of the
members of the community who have been touched by the events
leading to this honorarium.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately
upon its adoption and that the Clerk shall present the
resolution to Mr. Paul Banks and submit a copy to Mrs. Carolyn
Cannava, President of the School Board.
