WHEREAS, the Certification records that the proposition which read "Shall the boundaries of the Nikiski Fire Service Area be amended to include the Cook Inlet area in which the oil platforms are located, and the Tyonek Village area, and the area of the Beluga Coal Fields?" was approved by a Yes vote of 271 against a No vote of 162 with 435 persons voting in the election;

NOW THEREFORE, THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH DECLARES:

That the boundaries of the Nikiski Fire Service Area are amended to include the Cook Inlet area in which the oil platforms are located and the Tyonek Village area and the area of the Beluga Coal Fields"
