RESOLUTION 82-109

GRANTING AN EASEMENT ACROSS BOROUGH SELECTED LANDS TO
GLACIER STATE TELEPHONE COMPANY.

WHEREAS, the Borough has selected and received final approval for certain lands pursuant to the Municipal Selection Act; and

WHEREAS, Glacier State Telephone Company desires an easement for an existing buried communication cable which provides telephone service to residents; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has reviewed the easement request at its May 17, 1982 meeting;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That an easement 10 feet wide and centered on the existing buried communication cable along Beaver Creek Road and Hutler-Bald Mountain Road within Sec. 15, T5S R12W, S.M., be granted to Glacier State Telephone Company provided that Glacier State submits to the Borough an as-built survey showing cable locations and delineation of existing roads.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate this upon its adoption.
