RESOLUTION 82-119

AUTHORIZING UTILITY RELOCATION AGREEMENTS WITH GLACIER STATE
TELEPHONE COMPANY FOR HALBOUTY ROAD CONSTRUCTION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Borough proposes to reconstruct Halbouty Road;
and

WHEREAS, the road construction project requires the
adjustment or relocation of certain telephone utility facilities
within the proposed right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department and Glacier State
Telephone Company have negotiated a mutually satisfactory
arrangement for the utility relocation in conjunction with the
construction project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into an
agreement with Glacier State Telephone Company to provide for the
relocation of public utility telephone facilities located within
the right-of-way of Halbouty Road at the cost not to exceed
\$78,769 to be charged to the Halbouty Road Construction Account
#65-21037-9210.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect on the date of
its adoption.
