RESOLUTION 82-127

AUTHORIZING A UTILITY RELOCATION AGREEMENT WITH HOMER ELECTRIC ASSOCIATION FOR THE HALBOUTY ROAD CONSTRUCTION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Borough proposes to reconstruct Halbouty Road;  
and

WHEREAS, the road construction project requires the  
adjustment or relocation of certain electrical utility facilities  
within the proposed right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department and Homer Electric  
Association have negotiated a mutually satisfactory arrangement  
for the utility relocation in conjunction with the construction  
project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI  
PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into an  
agreement with Homer Electric Association to provide for the  
relocation of public utility facilities located within the right-  
of-way of Halbouty Road at a cost not to exceed \$25,631 to be  
charged to the Halbouty Road Construction Account #65-21037-9210.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect on the date of  
its adoption.
