KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 82-139

GRANTING AN ADDITIONAL 10 FEET OF RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR ROAD PURPOSES ACROSS BOROUGH LANDS ON THE HOMER HIGH SCHOOL PROPERTY WITHIN SECTION 19, T6S R13W, S.M., ALASKA.

WHEREAS, the Borough owns the Homer High School site;
and

WHEREAS, the Homer Advisory Planning Commission requested that the Borough dedicate 10 feet of right-of-way in addition to the 30 feet of right-of-way already dedicated to conform with Borough subdivision regulations; and

WHEREAS, a right-of-way could not be dedicated along private land in the area due to existing buildings; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Planning Commission at its June 7, 1982 meeting approved the right-of-way grant;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That 10 feet of additional right-of-way for road purposes across Borough lands on the Homer High School Property within Section 19, T6S R13W, S.M., Alaska be granted and shown on the plat of Benny Creek.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect on the date of its adoption, and the Mayor is authorized to sign the plat on behalf of the Borough granting the additional right-of-way.
