KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 82-143

RATIFYING A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH AND THE KENAI BOROUGH EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION RELATING TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 1982-83.

WHEREAS, Section 3.04.280 of the Borough Code of ordinances provides for the adoption of collective bargaining agreements by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Assembly, by Resolution 81-96, ratified the present collective bargaining agreement between the Borough and the Kenai Borough Employees Association, which expired on June 30, 1982; and

WHEREAS, through good-faith negotiations, an agreement has been reached between the Borough and the Kenai Borough Employees Association regarding wages, salaries, benefits and other terms and conditions of employment for the fiscal year 1982-83; and

WHEREAS, the collective bargaining agreement has been ratified by the Kenai Borough Employees Association, and the Administration recommends that the Assembly ratify the agreement for the Borough;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the collective bargaining agreement between the Borough and the Kenai Borough Employees Association effective June 28, 1982 through June 30, 1983, approved as Attachment A, is ratified and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. That this resolution is retroactive to June 28, 1982, if the collective bargaining agreement has been duly ratified by the Kenai Borough Employees Association, or on such later date that this resolution is adopted by the Assembly.
