RESOLUTION 82-160

SUPPORTING THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL'S REQUEST FOR PLACING THE QUESTION REGARDING NUCLEAR ARMS ON THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH REGULAR OCTOBER ELECTION BALLOT.

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council has requested by Resolution 82-27 that the Kenai Peninsula Borough place on the ballot a proposition providing for a vote of the people concerning nuclear arms proliferation;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the following proposition be placed on the October 5, 1982 Borough election ballot:

"Should the United States adopt, as an immediate goal, the negotiation with the Soviet Union of a bilateral and verifiable nuclear freeze treaty, banning the testing, production and deployment of new nuclear weapons and their delivery systems?"

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect on the date of its adoption.
