KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 82-168

PROVIDING THAT THE COST OF ANY PROJECT SET FOR APPROVAL BY THE VOTERS ON OCTOBER 5, 1982 SHALL BE REDUCED PROPORTIONATELY IN ORDER TO QUALIFY FOR FULL NINETY PERCENT FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Education, contributes to the Borough ninety percent of the cost of any approved project and this represents a great savings for the Borough taxpayers who are not forced to bear the full cost of bonded indebtedness; and

WHEREAS, the State has informed the Borough that the Kenai Central High School auditorium addition project and the Homer High School project, both of which have been placed before the voters for approval on October 5, 1982 may not qualify for the full ninety percent State contribution because the scope and cost of the projects relative to the present student population of each school exceeds the scope and cost currently allowed by State regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education at its regular meeting of August 16, 1982 recommended that the cost and scope of any project which did not qualify for the full ninety percent State contribution be reduced to the point that the State will assume ninety percent of the project costs; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Assembly to reduce the cost of either of these bonded projects to the extent necessary to qualify for ninety percent State reimbursement;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly hereby announces its intention, in the event that either the Kenai Central High School auditorium project or the new Homer High School project as currently designed, are not approved for full State reimbursement of ninety percent of the project costs, then the Assembly shall provide for the redesign of the project and a reduction in scope and cost until such projects qualify for the current ninety percent reimbursement by the State of Alaska.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
