RESOLUTION 82-185

AWARDING A CONTRACT TO MULLIKIN SURVEYS TO CONDUCT PRELIMINARY SURVEY WORK FOR ANCHOR RIVER ROAD, PHASE II.

WHEREAS, the Assembly desires to provide for the upgrading of Anchor River Road; and

WHEREAS, the Borough cannot proceed with the design of this project until the proposed road alignment has been surveyed; and

WHEREAS, the firm of Mullikin Surveys has proposed to perform all necessary preliminary survey work for Phase II in accordance with the request for proposal, and produced the right-of-way map for a fee in the amount not to exceed \$125,270;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the proposal of Mullikin Surveys to perform preliminary survey work and draw the right-of-way map for Anchor River Road Phase II in an amount not to exceed \$125,270 is accepted and a contract is awarded. All expenditures for this project shall be charged to the Anchor River Road Survey Account #66-21036-9214.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate this resolution, which takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
