RESOLUTION 82-194

AUTHORIZING A TELEPHONE UTILITY RELOCATION AGREEMENT WITH GLACIER STATE TELEPHONE COMPANY FOR THE MYERS/STRAWBERRY ROAD CONSTRUCTION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Borough proposes to reconstruct Myers/- Strawberry Road; and

WHEREAS, the road construction project requires the adjustment or relocation of certain utility facilities within the proposed right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department, and Glacier State Telephone Company negotiated a mutually satisfactory arrangement for the utility relocation in conjunction with the construction project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Glacier State Telephone Company to provide for the relocation of telephone facilities located within the right-of-way of Myers/Strawberry Road at a cost not to exceed \$43,925 which is to be charged to the Myers/Strawberry Road Utility Acct. No. 65-21040-9290.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
