RESOLUTION 82-196

TRANSFERRING FUNDS FROM THE BOND CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE HOMER HIGH SCHOOL ACCOUNT FOR THE PURCHASE OF A SCHOOL BUILDING SITE AT HOMER, ALASKA.

WHEREAS, the School Board has recommended that there be placed on the ballot a proposition concerning a high school in Homer, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Assembly has placed the proposition on the October 5, 1982 regular Borough election ballot; and

WHEREAS, there is a property well suited to development as a high school site with access from the East Road and there is available sewer and water facilities at a reasonable price; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the amount of \$400,000 is transferred from the Bond Fund Contingency Acct. No. 62-10082-9007 to Homer High School Acct. No. 62-11682-9007 for the purchase of a building site.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate this resolution which takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
