RESOLUTION 82-203

URGING BETTER ENFORCEMENT OF GRAZING LEASE REGULATIONS COVERED UNDER 11 AAC 60

WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of the Borough Assembly that grazing leases granted under 11 AAC 60 are not being utilized, and timely action by the directors of Division of Agriculture, and the Division of Land and Water Management is not being taken against nonusers; and

WHEREAS, there is a high demand for these leases by prospective users; and

WHEREAS, nonuse is a detriment to agricultural land use within the Kenai Peninsula Borough;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Commissioner of Natural Resources is hereby urged to enforce all terms to the fullest extent of the law of existing grazing leases and take appropriate action against nonusers.

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby requested to distribute this resolution to the Governor, Legislators, and to the Commissioner of Natural Resources.
