KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 82-209

GRANTING A UTILITY EASEMENT ACROSS BOROUGH LANDS TO GLACIER STATE TELEPHONE COMPANY.

WHEREAS, the Borough has selected and received final approval to certain lands in Section 9, T2N, R12W, S.M.; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has received a request for a utility easement across those lands from Glacier State Telephone Company to install telephone lines on existing Homer Electric Association poles; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission considered the request and recommended the easement be granted at its October 18, 1982 meeting;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That a utility easement be granted to Glacier State Telephone Company to coincide with a right-of-way permit granted to Homer Electric Association through ADL52390.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect on the date of its adoption, and the Mayor is authorized to execute the authorized easement with such terms and conditions as he deems necessary to preserve the interests and rights of the Borough.
