RESOLUTION 82-218

URGING THE ASSEMBLY TO SUPPORT THE ANCHOR POINT VFW APPLICATION FOR A GRANT UNDER THE ALASKA RURAL DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A COMMUNITY CENTER TO SERVE THE CITIZEN AND SERVICE NEEDS OF THE ANCHOR POINT AREA.

WHEREAS, the Rural Development Assistance Grant Program is administered through the Department of Community and Regional Affairs providing special grants for a wide variety of small community needs including community center buildings; and

WHEREAS, the unincorporated community of Anchor Point is in need of a multi-purpose community center to provide adequate facilities for a Senior Citizen Center, a properly appointed public library, plus accommodations for the wide variety of services, meetings and events essential in the day to day life of a growing community area; and

WHEREAS, the Anchor Point Veterans of Foreign Wars Post No. 10221 has taken the lead to develop a community center to provide for the community needs at Anchor Point; and

WHEREAS, the Anchor Point VFW Post has applied for project funding under the Rural Development Assistance Program, and has requested the endorsement of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly supports the Anchor Point VFW application for a grant under the Alaska Rural Development Assistance program for the development of a community center to serve the citizen and service needs of the Anchor Point area.


