KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 82-27

APPROVING AGREEMENTS WITH THE STATE OF ALASKA AND THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE RELATING TO THE CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE, AND LOCATION OF THE RESURRECTION RIVER PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE, AND SPECIAL USE PERMITS FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR.

WHEREAS, the Assembly has by Resolution 81-174 and Resolution 81-204 authorized the Borough to construct the Resurrection River Bridge; and

WHEREAS, the project requires the cooperative agreements of the State of Alaska and the National Park Service; and

WHEREAS, these agreements have been negotiated which will provide that the State of Alaska will be a party to the project and is providing financing for the construction of the bridge, and the National Park Service is willing to accept the bridge and to undertake the maintenance of it; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has obtained the agreement of the National Park Service that the title to the bridge shall revert to the Borough if the National Park Service cannot use and relocate the bridge at the Exit Glacier area of the Kenai Fjords National Park; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly approves these negotiated arrangements;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly approves and authorizes agreements with the State of Alaska and the National Park Service which will provide for the construction of the bridge by the Borough, and the maintenance of the bridge by the National Park Service; and further providing that title to the bridge shall revert to the Borough in the event that the National Park Service cannot relocate the pedestrian bridge in the Exit Glacier area of Kenai Fjords National Park. The Assembly authorizes the procurement of special use permits from the U.S. Department of Interior.

Section 2. The Mayor is authorized to execute this resolution which takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
