RESOLUTION 82-38

ALLOCATING ROAD DESIGN GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LEGISLATIVE INTENT.

WHEREAS, the Borough Assembly accepted a special road design grant from the State of Alaska in the amount of \$1,065,000 by Ordinance 81-85; and

WHEREAS, the State Legislature established its intended use of the funds and how they should be disbursed; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly desires to allocate those funds in accordance with the legislative intent;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. The secondary road design grant of \$1,065,000 shall be allocated as follows:



