KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 82-39

AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT AND THE SCHOOL DISTRICT TO CONDUCT A STUDY INTO THE FEASIBILITY OF REHABILITATING THE CELLAR ROOM IN THE SEWARD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL FOR A CIVIL DEFENSE AND STORAGE FACILITY.

WHEREAS, the State Fire Marshall has rendered a basement cellar room in the Seward Elementary School useless by siting the requirement for a fire sprinkling system and additional access and exits; and

WHEREAS, the room is suitable only for a storage facility or auxiliary civil defense use; and

WHEREAS, this room is not suitable for human activities or habitation or recreation because of the low ceiling, among other things; and

~~WHEREAS, an additional stairway and a sidewalk elevator may be needed to make this room useable, and~~

WHEREAS, it is prudent for the Borough to ascertain whether or not this room can be put to suitable uses instead of remaining vacant and useless.

NOW THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Borough Public Works Department and the School District conduct an evaluation of the needs and expense which would be involved in rehabilitating the basement storage at the Seward Elementary School in order to pass the State Fire Prevention Code and to determine the advisability and feasibility of making the room suitable for storage or an auxiliary civil defense facility by the installation of additional exits and access and a sprinkling system, together with an additional stairway and sidewalk elevator. After the conclusion of this investigation and study, a report by written memorandum shall be submitted to the Assembly.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
