RESOLUTION 82-45

AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR SURVEYOR'S COMPUTATIONS OF ROADS AND LOTS FOR GRAY CLIFF SUBDIVISION.

WHEREAS, the Borough has obtained title from the State of Alaska to approximately 5,000 acres of land lying north of Captain Cook State Recreation Area within T9N, R9W, S.M., State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has authorized the Administration to provide for the disposal of these lands to the general public at the earliest practicable time; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has contracted to provide for the preliminary platting of these lands as a subdivision; and

WHEREAS, McLane and Associates has proposed to perform all necessary work in accordance with its proposal of February 24, 1982; and

WHEREAS, the Land Resource Management Department has reviewed this proposal and has recommended that the Assembly accept the proposal of McLane and Associates:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:



Section 1. That the proposal of McLane and Associates to perform all work necessary for street and lot boundary computations for Gray Cliff Subdivision for a lump sum cost of \$12,000 be accepted, and a contract is authorized.
