KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 82-51

URGING THE TWELFTH ALASKA STATE LEGISLATURE, SECOND SESSION, TO FUND THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AT A SUFFICIENT LEVEL TO ENSURE THE PROTECTION AND WELL BEING OF THE CITIZENS OF THE STATE.

WHEREAS, the Twelfth Alaska Legislature, Second Session is presently convened and making determinations regarding funding levels; and

WHEREAS, the life protection and well being of the citizens of the State of Alaska should be of the highest priority; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety primarily concerns itself with the funding of the Alaska State Troopers, fire safety, driver/vehicle services, highway safety planning, victim services, and illicit narcotic distribution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly approves and supports a level of funding to the Department of Public Safety that will assure the continuance and stability of the services the Department currently provides for the safety and welfare of the residents of Alaska.

Section 2. That this resolution shall be served upon Jay S. Hammond, Governor of the State of Alaska; Jalmar Kerttula, President of the State Senate; Joe L. Hayes, Speaker of the House; Donald E. Gilman, State Senator; Bette Cato, Hugh Malone, and Pat O'Connell, State Representatives.

Section 3. This Resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
