RESOLUTION 82-55

URGING THE SECOND SESSION OF THE TWELFTH ALASKA LEGISLATURE TO MAINTAIN AT LEAST THE CURRENT BUDGET APPROPRIATION LEVELS IN THE STATE EDUCATION SCHOOL FOUNDATION FUND AND TO DEFEAT ANY PROPOSALS TO REDUCE THE FUND IN FISCAL YEAR 1982-83.

WHEREAS, the State Legislature is presently in session in Juneau; and

WHEREAS, one of the important budget proposals is the funding of the State's Education School Foundation Fund; and

WHEREAS, various proposals to cut State spending include a reduction in the legislative appropriation for the school foundation fund; and

WHEREAS, it is essential that the State legislature continues to appropriate an adequate fund in the school foundation fund in order to promote the continuing advancement of education objectives throughout the State's school system.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Twelfth Legislature, Second Session, is urged by the Assembly to continue at least the level of budget appropriations currently in existence for the State's Educational School Foundation Fund, and furthermore, that any and all efforts to cut the existing level of appropriations be defeated.

Section 2. That this resolution shall be served upon State of Alaska Governor Jay S. Hammond, Senate President Jay Kerttula, Speaker of the House Joe L. Hays, State Senator Don Gilman, Representatives Hugh Malone, Pat O'Connell and Bette Cato.
