POSTPONING PHASE II OF THE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT AT THE CENTRAL KENAI PENINSULA HOSPITAL PENDING A DETERMINATION OF STATE AID TO BE ENACTED BY THE ALASKA STATE LEGISLATURE IN THE 1982 SESSION.

WHEREAS, the Central Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area Board has approved the construction of improvements known as Phase II; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has approved Phase II of the construction project at the hospital and has authorized the issuance of general obligation bonds of the Service Area; and

WHEREAS, the original intention was to let a contract for the construction project of Phase II in the construction season of 1982; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the State legislature have indicated that the legislature is considering a bond issue to be approved by the people of the State of Alaska which would authorize various capital improvements including hospitals; and

WHEREAS, if such legislation is enacted, the Borough may be the recipient on behalf of the Central Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area of State monies to finance all or a part of Phase II construction project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly approves postponing the construction project of Phase II at the Central Kenai Peninsula Hospital pending determination of funding levels by the Twelfth Legislature, Second Session, which authorize capital improvements including hospitals, subject to the approval of the voters at the general election in 1982. In the event that the legislature funds all or a part of the Phase II construction costs, the project will proceed as soon as is possible depending upon the State administration; provided however, that if no State funding is forthcoming the Borough will undertake to proceed with the construction of Phase II as soon as a determination is made of State funding and aid.
