KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 82-63

CLASSIFYING A PARCEL OF BOROUGH-PATENTED PROPERTY AS PUBLIC USE LAND AND APPROVING THE USE OF THIS LAND FOR A SCHOOL SITE.

WHEREAS, the Borough acquired title to land in the Kalifornsky Beach Road area from the State of Alaska under Patent No. 6113; and

WHEREAS, a site is needed for a proposed elementary school in the Kalifornsky Beach Road area; and

WHEREAS, the School Board unanimously approved this site at its regularly scheduled meeting held on March 15, 1982; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Planning Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting held on March 22, 1982 reviewed the School Board's request for reclassification;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Borough-patented land described as Government Lot 2, Section 1, Township 4 North, Range 11 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska, containing 39.48 acres, more or less is reclassified to "Public Use" land.

Section 2. That this site may be used for a proposed elementary school in the Kalifornsky Beach Road area, or other public use approved by the Assembly.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
