RESOLUTION 82-64

AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT FOR CLEARING CENTERLINES OF ROADS
WITHIN GRAY CLIFF SUBDIVISION.

WHEREAS, the Borough has obtained title from the State of Alaska to approximately 5,000 acres of land lying north of Captain Cook State Recreation Area within T9N R9W, S.M., State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly has authorized the disposal of these lands to the general public at the earliest practicable time; and

WHEREAS, McLane and Associates has proposed to perform all work necessary for street centerline clearing in accordance with its proposal of March 18, 1982; and

WHEREAS, the Land Resource Management Department has reviewed this proposal and recommends the acceptance of this proposal;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the proposal of McLane and Associates to perform all work necessary for street centerline clearing within Gray Cliff Subdivision for a lump sum cost of \$135,000 is accepted, and a contract is authorized.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to effectuate this resolution, which takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
