RESOLUTION 82-67

DESIGNATING THE NEWSPAPER AND AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THE PROPERTY TAX FORECLOSURE LIST FOR THE TAX YEAR 1981.

WHEREAS, the Borough is required by statute to publish an annual foreclosure list setting forth the names and amounts of all delinquent real property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has opened bids for the performance of all work required to print, publish and distribute the 1981 real property tax foreclosure list; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Department estimates that the contractor will be required to publish approximately 200 computer pages for the 1981 tax foreclosure list; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Department has evaluated the bids and recommends an award of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly is required to designate the newspaper which will publish the foreclosure list;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the bid of the to perform all work necessary to print, publish and distribute the real property tax foreclosure list for the 1981 tax year for a unit price of \$68.48 per page of computer printout is accepted, and a contract for this work is awarded to this designated newspaper. The publication shall begin with the week of April 12, 1982, and be printed each week for four consecutive weeks. The total contract price shall be determined by multiplying the number of computer printout pages which the contractor must publish by the bid price per page. All expenditures for this contract shall be charged to Account No. 01.41310.2300.

Section 2. That the contract will be adjusted by any increase in postal rates that may take effect prior to the final publication date.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
