RESOLUTION 82-73

APPROVING THE SCHOOL BOARD'S SELECTION OF INLET ARCHITECTS TO STUDY THE SEWARD SCHOOL FACILITY DEFICIENCIES.

WHEREAS, the Seward school administration, community, City of Seward, Public Works Department, and the School Board have outlined numerous deficiencies at the Seward school; and

WHEREAS, the School Board recommends Inlet Architects to study the Seward school facility deficiencies as a basis to decide on feasible modifications; and

WHEREAS, \$40,000 is available for an overall study from funds budgeted for relighting classrooms; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project warrants the services of a consultant to outline the deficiencies and develop a master plan;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Assembly approves the School Board's selection of Inlet Architects to study the Seward school facilities.

Section 2. That this Resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption, and the Mayor is authorized to negotiate a contract for professional services to develop a concept and master plan to implement needed improvements at the Seward school.
